TEACHER AVAILABILITY

TIMES	Recommended daily student learning engagements from CECV <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Foundation - Grade 2: Literacy 45-60mins, Numeracy 30-45 mins, Additional Learning Areas / Play-based Learning 30-45 mins (minimum 1 and ¾ hours - 2 and ½ hours per day).• Grade 3-6: Literacy 45-60mins, Numeracy 30-45 mins, Physical Activity 45 mins and Additional Curriculum Areas 90 mins (minimum 2 and ¾ hours - 3 and ¾ hours per day).
Attendance Record	As schools are legally required to record an attendance roll we require students to check-in with their teacher daily. Please login into your child's Google Classroom. Select "Classwork" and "Attendance" to record that your child is present and working. If your child is unwell, please complete a Parent Notified Absence via Simon Everywhere / PAM or telephone the office.
9.00am	Classroom teachers online. Morning check-in with students.
9.05am - 1.30pm	Classroom teachers will be available to provide direction and feedback to students. Class "Google Meet" sessions will be scheduled throughout the week. Usual breaks such as First Break and Second Break will be taken. <i>We suggest you could set up your daily schedule as follows:</i> <i>Reading Activity</i> <i>Break</i> <i>Writing Activity</i> <i>Break</i> <i>Maths</i> <i>Break</i> <i>Optional Extra</i>
1.45pm - 2.45pm	Teachers will be meeting, collaborating and planning with colleagues. Students may continue learning programs if required <u>but online direction and feedback will occur either later in the day or the following morning.</u>
2.45pm - 3.30pm	Classroom teachers will be available to provide direction and feedback to students. End of school day.
3.30pm - 5.00pm	Teachers will be meeting with colleagues for staff meetings and team meetings as per usual schedule.

Parents and Carers who have any questions, queries or concerns regarding their child are asked to contact teachers via email.

All parents and carers should already have the appropriate @spcamperdown.catholic.edu.au email address for their child's teacher. Teachers will respond within a reasonable timeframe and within School Hours. We suggest that any email received by families from their child's teacher or the school are saved into a folder so that they can be easily accessed for future reference.
